

# POST-HUMAN ARCHITECT Competence Framework

## PRESS RELEASE

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Post-Human Architect project aims at developing, testing, and disseminating an innovative methodology to be used by VET organisations and trainers in decentralized areas to educate young learners to sustainability and social innovation. By implementing this methodology, we aim at contributing to the building and reinforcement of resilient, future-proof and more attractive VET systems in decentralized areas, which can support young people to find educational opportunities and new job opportunities tailored to their needs.

The Post Human Architect project has developed a [Competence framework](#) based upon a best practice collection and focus group results in partners countries and with reference to the Post Human Architecture methodology and New

European Bauhaus goal and values (EU, 2022): *The New European Bauhaus is a creative and interdisciplinary initiative that connects the European Green Deal to our living spaces and experiences. The competence framework was developed based upon focus group results in partners countries. Prior to the focus groups each partner selected and presented two best practices from each country followed up by stakeholder analysis and engagement presenting best practices as an example of Post Human Architecture in practices. The objective of the skills and competence framework was to create a self-assessment grid that can both be applied in training and self-learning. The framework includes definition and descriptors for each competence elaborating on the relevant knowledge, skills and attitudes. The competence framework builds on European sustainability competence framework ([Green Comp](#)) and other relevant frameworks for soft skills and sustainability as well as soft skills and competences like cultural sensitivity, community engagement and inclusion

Starting from the competence framework we are now developing a methodology to teach to the future post-human architect how to manage a post-human project.
